Publishing opportunities:

- Conference Proceedings, submissions not less than three thousand words, no limits regarding number of authors per a paper.
- The book edited by international editorial board, titled "Handbook of Research on Tools and Techniques for Economic Decision Analysis", and published by IGI Global (Pennsylvania, USA) will gather a selection of the best submissions (primarily technically developed papers), but will not be limited to the conference submissions. The papers have to be eligible in terms of overall quality, content and length. Between eight and ten thousand words with no more than three authors per a paper.
- The academic journal Economic Themes. The papers submitted for the journal will undergo the journal's regular review process (<http://www.degruyter.com/view/j/ethemes>).
